Tips for Raising Good Listeners

- 1. Teach your kids to look the person who is talking in the eyes.
- 2. Help your kids learn to pay close attention to what someone is saying.
- 3. Teach your kids to nod, make small noises or facial expressions to let the person who is speaking know they are listening carefully.
- 4. Train your kids to focus on what the other person is saying instead of thinking about what they want to say next.
- 5. Teach your kids to not interrupt the person who is speaking.
- 6. Train your kids to ask questions if they don't understand something that is said.
- 7. Teach your kids how to summarize what the other person said to make sure they understood it.
- 8. Encourage your kids to try to imagine what the speaker is feeling about what they are saying.
- 9. Teach your kids how to listen to what isn't said out loud, like body language, facial expressions, tone of voice, etc.
