



S.M.A.R.T. Goal Worksheet

S – Specific

M – Measurable

A – Achievable

R - Realistic

T – Time Bound

When creating S.M.A.R.T. goals for your ministry to children and teens, focus on goals that are specific and measurable. As Christians, we know God will decide whether they are achievable or realistic and their timing. Your ministry should have no more than three or four short-term goals at any one time. (You may choose to create a much longer long-term goal list and periodically move items from that list to the one for short-term goals.)

Example: Instead of *“Our students will become Christians,”* try *“Three students will ask to study baptism outside of class and decide to become Christians this semester”*
